

AUTOMATIC SUNDAY OFFERING

DIRECT DEBIT PROGRAM

Question: What is Automatic Offering and how does it work?

Answer: With direct debit, your Sunday offerings are combined into a once a month total, and automatically paid to the parish account.

Question: Do I have to change financial institutions to utilize the Automatic Offering?

Answer: Your current financial institution is probably capable of accommodating direct debits. There are 17,500 institutions in the U.S. who are connected to the network.

Question: How do I sign up?

Answer: You simply complete an authorization agreement that can be obtained from the Parish office. Sign the form and return it to the Parish office with either a voided check or Savings deposit ticket attached.

Question: What if I change banks or want to increase my contribution?

Answer: You will need to inform the Parish office and complete a new authorization. Then we will designate your new monthly contribution to be debited from your account.

Question: What if I start the Automatic Offering and wish to cancel it?

Notify the Parish office in writing to cancel your authorization agreement.

Question: Will the Automatic Offering cost me anything in the way of additional service charges?

Answer: You will not incur service charges associated with Automatic Offering.

Question: How do I know that my Automatic Sunday Offering has been made each month?

Answer: The debit will appear on your bank statement which your financial institution sends you.
